Vegetables

ALL SEED PACKETS - \$3.90ea. Members \$3.51ea

AMARANTH - Grain

(*Amaranthus hypochondriacus*)

Organic

Annual versatile plant, leaves rich in vitamins and minerals. Low in oxalic acid, eat in salads or cooked. Seeds are white, high in protein, can be popped. Sow Spring-Summer.

AMARANTH - Grain Golden

(*Amaranthus hypochondriacus*)

AusQual

Fast growing annual to 1.5 metres high. Green leaves eaten like spinach when young, produces a soft golden flower head when seeds mature. Seeds have a high protein content. Used in cereal. Sow Spring-Summer.

AMARANTH - Leaf (*Amaranthus gangeticus*)

AusQual

Annual, grows to 1.5 metres, leaves and stems used like spinach. Sow Spring-Summer. High in protein, vitamins and minerals.

ARTICHOKE - Globe (*Cynara scolymus*)

AusQual

Grows to 1.5 metres, a prized delicacy. Used steamed, casseroles and preserves. Fast growing, likes rich well drained soil. Sow Autumn, Winter, Spring.

BEAN - BUSH (*Phaseolus vulgaris*)

High yielding and rich in protein. Plant every 3 weeks for continuous supply. Sow Spring-Summer.

- Brown Beauty

AusQual

- Old variety, french strain, disease resistant.

- Butter Bush

AusQual

Compact grower to 45cm, producing crop of yellow pods, black seed, stringless when picked young, good flavour.

- Dwarf (BBL 156)

AusQual

Compact grower with round stringless pods to 15cm long. A high yielding variety and excellent taste.

- Hawkesbury Wonder

AusQual

Popular old stringless variety, produces over a long period, green pods to 15cm long.

- Prestons

AusQual

Old variety producing tasty, round green pods over a long period. Bushy plant to 45cm.

BEAN - CLIMBING (*Phaseolus vulgaris*)

Take up little room and yield over a long period, provide trellis. Sow Spring-Summer.

- Delgado Black Mexican

AusQual

Climber to 2 metres, green pods, black seeds. Mature seeds used as dry bean, also useful as black dye.

- Fredrico

AusQual

Strong grower to 2 metre. Green stringless, good yields over a long period.

- Greek Bean

AusQual

Strong growing variety, producing good crop of flat green, stringless pods to 15cm long.

- Kentucky Wonder

AusQual

Vigorous grower, producing green, fleshy, flat pods. Stringless when young to 20cm, rust resistant.

- Lablab (*Dolichocho lablab*)

AusQual

Vigorous perennial in warm climates to 2.5 metres. Pods eaten steamed or boiled when young. Black seeds, excellent legume, ground cover & soil improver.

- Lazy Housewife

AusQual

Stringless bean to 2 metres, originating from Germany. Good flavour, heavy bearing, green flat pods to 20cm long.

- Madagascar (*Phaseolus lunatus*)

AusQual

Perennial climber to 2 metres, wiry growth with red & white coloured seeds. Young pods steamed and seeds used as a dry soup bean when mature.

- Purple King

AusQual

Flat purple pod to 18cm popular variety. Pods turn green when cooked. Adds colour and flavour to salads.

- Rice Bean

AusQual

Dense spreading variety for ground cover or trellis. Good nitrogen fixer, green manure and soil improver. Small green pods eaten steamed. Suited to warm climates

- Snake Bean - Black (*Vigna unguiculata*)

AusQual

Strong grower, yields 45cm long pods of black seeds, eat fresh or cooked.

- Snake Bean - Brown (*Vigna unguiculata*)

AusQual

Long, extra thin pods to 60cm, climber to 2 metres high, brown seeds. Use as for black snake bean.

- Snake Bean - Red Noodle

AusQual

Climber to 2 metres producing juicy red pods to 60cm long. Tender crunchy beans retain colour when cooked, prolific bearing.

- Wellington Wonder

AusQual

Flat green pods to 20cm. Prolific cropping, good flavour. Climbs to 2 metres.

- Zebra

AusQual

Stringless when picked young, strong grower, old variety.

BEETROOT (*Beta vulgaris*)

Popular root vegetable, fast growing, bi-annual, easy to grow. Sow direct in garden, 60 days to maturity. Keep moist in fertile well drained soil. Use in salads, cooked or preserved. Sow all year except in hot weather.

- Bulls Blood

Organic

Attractive dark red leaves. Used in salads and cooked foods. Good flavour, dark red zoned root.

- Burpee's Golden

AusQual

Sweet golden flesh, milder flavour, green tops used like spinach. Used in salads, cooked & steamed.

- Chiogga

AusQual

Also known as Candy Stripe. Attractive red skinned beetroot with red & white rings.

- Cylindra

AusQual

Cylindrical variety, smooth dark red roots up to 20cm long. Tender and sweet flavour.

- Detroit - Red

AusQual

Round red roots to 12cm across. Smooth, tender, sweet flavour.

- Early Wonder Top

Organic

Produces tall leafy tops, excellent greens, Attractive red root with colour zones.

BOK CHOY - Chinese Cabbage (*Brassica rapa*)

AusQual

Annual loose cabbage with large green leaves & crunchy white stems. Harvest large leaves over a long period. Sow Autumn-Spring.

BROAD BEAN - Coles Dwarf Prolific (*Vicia faba*)

AusQual

Compact grower to 1 metre, good cropper with 20cm pods. Eaten fresh or cooked. Do not over fertilise. Sow Autumn - Spring.

BROCCOLI (*Brassica oleracea*)

Rich in calcium, vitamins and minerals. Sow all year except hot weather.

- Albert

AusQual

Compact plant, dark green large heads.

- DiCicco

AusQual

Compact Italian variety. Blue-green heads to 10cm across, produces over a long period. Harvest at 60 days.

- Purple Sprouting

AusQual

Attractive purple headed broccoli that forms a colour contrast to the lush green leaves and stems. Adds nutrition and colour to dishes.

- Umpqua

AusQual

Heavy bearing variety with a high quality main head then ample side shoots for multiple weeks. Leaves can be eaten when young in salads or lightly blanched.

BROOM MILLET (*Sorghum bicolor*) AusQual

Tall grass like annual to 3 metres. Decorative straw like flower. Seed heads used to make brooms. Sow Spring-Summer.

CABBAGE (*Brassica oleracea*)

Popular vegetable, high in calcium and iron. Likes fertile well drained soil, sunny position, frost hardy. Sow all year, except hot conditions.

- Green Express AusQual

Early producing variety, forming small tight green heads to 1.5kg. 60 days to maturity from transplant. Popular vegetable, high in calcium and iron. Likes fertile, well drained soil, sunny position, frost hardy. Compact variety that can be spaced 35cm apart. Sow all year except in hot conditions.

- Red AusQual

Medium sized. Adds attractive colour to salads.

CAPSICUM (*Capsicum annuum*)

Popular Summer vegetable, high yielding, shrubby plants for warm sunny position. Yield over a long period. Sow Spring - Summer.

- Californian Wonder AusQual

Sweet fruit, cube shaped 10 cm, bell type, heavy producer use green or red, high in Vitamin C.

- Diamond AusQual

Small white diamond shaped fruit, produced in abundance. Capsicum changes from white to light orange on maturity.

- Golden Californian Wonder AusQual

Compact bush to 60cm high, sweet capsicum to 10cm, block shape fruit, green ripening to yellow-gold. Adds colour to salads and cooked dishes.

- Jimmy Nardello AusQual

Heavy producing Italian variety with long red sweet fruit to 25cm. Continuous cropper, excellent tasting variety and great for stuffing. Popular Summer vegetable, high yielding, shrubby plant for warm sunny position. Sow Spring-Summer.

- Peperone AusQual

Long thin and crinkly fruit with the aroma of a chilli but usually no heat when eaten. Stores well and can be harvested green to red. Grows to 60cm high, Full sun well drained fertile position. Sow Spring-Summer.

CARROT (*Daucus carota*)

Popular root vegetable, for deep well drained soil, sunny position. Do not over feed, keep moist. Sow All Year.

- Chantenay Red Cored AusQual

Short roots to 12cm, orange red colour. Ideal for shallow soils.

- Danvers AusQual

Hardy variety to suit most soils. Slender, deep orange colour to 15cm long, tolerates hot conditions. Eat fresh. Suited to freezing. Popular root vegetable, for deep well drained soil. Sunny position. Sow all year.

- Purple Dragon AusQual

Smooth purple coloured skin with light orange core. Root to 20cm long, high in antioxidants, 70 days to maturity.

- Western Red AusQual

Long tapering root, smooth deep orange colour. Disease resistant. 70 days to maturity.

CAULIFLOWER - Snowball (*Brassica oleracea*) Organic

Produces white heads to 15cm across. Suited to warmer climates. Sow Autumn-Winter.

CELERY (*Apium graveolens var dulce*) Sow Autumn-Spring.

- Chinese (*Brassica juncea*) AusQual

Grows to 60 cm, with large spicy flavoured leaves, 3-4 cm wide midrib & tapered at the end. Midrib is crunchy, juicy & sweet, can be eaten fresh or cooked.

- Red Stem (*Apium graveolens var dulce*) AusQual

Compact habit with thin stalks that colour to a reddish purple. Good flavour. Use stalks and leaves fresh when required.

- Tall Utah Organic

Dark green stringless stems to 70cm.

- Tendercrisp AusQual

Likes rich well drained soil and ample water. Green smooth stringless, very hardy.

CHIA (*Salvia rhyacophila*) AusQual

Hardy annual to 1.5 metres, leaves used in salads, seeds for sprouts. Seeds rich in vitamins and protein, forage plant. Whole plant regarded as survival food. Sow Spring-Summer.

►CHICORY - Palla Rosa (*Cichorium intybus*) AusQual

Also known as Radicchio. Dark green outer leaves, with a 10-15cm red wine coloured head and white ribs. Attractive variety, bitter & spicy taste. Use in Italian dishes, salads, steamed and boiled. Sow Autumn-Spring.

CHILLI (*Capsicum annuum*)

Hardy Summer vegetable, high yielding. Adds flavour to cooked dishes. Ideal for bottling. Sow Spring-Summer, plant in good, well drained soil in sunny position. Sow Spring - Summer.

- Aji Limon (*Capsicum baccatum*) AusQual

Popular annual to 90cm, producing yellow chillies to 6cm long. Originating from Peru. Heat Level: 5/10 Use fresh or dried. Ideal for spicy cooked foods, sauces, bottling & insecticidal spray.

- Anaheim AusQual

An upright bushy habit producing long blocky, red fruit to 15cm. Heat level 3. Hardy summer vegetable, high yielding. Adds flavour to cooked dishes. Ideal for bottling. Plant in good, well drained soil in sunny position. Sow Spring-Summer.

- Bell (*Capsicum baccatum*) AusQual

Grows to 80cm, colourful lantern shaped fruit. Green ripening to red. Ornamental specimen, South American species. Heat level 6/10.

- Black Pearl (*Capsicum annuum*) AusQual

Highly ornamental plant to 45cm high with deep purple-black leaves. Small round fruit, black to red. Heat level 6/10.

- Cayenne (*Capsicum annuum*) AusQual

Slender fruit to 10cm long, green turning to red. Medium heat, level 6/10.

- Explosive Ember (*Capsicum annuum*) AusQual

Popular annual to 45cm, producing small purple/red chillies to 3cm long. Ideal in pots. Heat level 6/10. Use fresh or dried. Perfect for growing in pots. Ideal for spicy cooked foods, sauces, bottling & insecticidal spray.

- Fatalii (*Capsicum chinense*) AusQual

Popular annual to 1m, producing tubular golden chillies to 6cm long. Heat level 10/10. Use fresh or dried. Ideal for spicy cooked foods, sauces, bottling & insecticidal spray

- Fiesta (*Capsicum annuum*) AusQual

Compact low spreading ground cover. Fruit 9cm long, changing from cream/purple to orange then red. Heat level 5/10. Ideal to plant in pots or garden.

- Habanero - Chocolate (*Capsicum chinense*) AusQual

Fruit ripens from green to chocolate brown, measuring up to 6cm long & 2.5cm wide with waxy coating. Flavour rich, fruity, smokey. Grow up to 90cm high. Heat level 9/10.

- Habanero - Orange (*Capsicum chinense*) AusQual

Compact plant to 60cm high. Bright orange coloured fruit to 5cm long. Hot fruity flavour. Heat level 8/10.

- Hot Thai (*Capsicum annuum*) AusQual

Popular annual to 60cm, producing plenty of narrow red chillis to 7cm long. Originates from Thailand, used in red currys. Heat level 8/10. Use fresh or dried.

- Hungarian Black (*Capsicum annuum*) AusQual

Bushing habit to 80cm, produces plenty of narrow black ripening to red fruit up to 5cm long. Originates from Hungary. Heat level 3/10. Use fresh or dried. Ideal for adding colour and spice in sauces.

- Jalapeno AusQual

Popular variety, fruit red or green, hot, 8cm long, thick flesh, original Mexican chillies. Heat level 4/10.

- Paprika (*Capsicum annuum*) AusQual

Narrow red fruits to 8cm. long. Dried & ground into powder or use as mild chillies. Heat level 1/10.

- **Peter Peppers Penis** (*Capsicum annum*) **AusQual**

As the name suggests this chilli does grow similar in shape. Lower growing plant suitable for garden or pots. Annual to 80cm, producing bumpy red fruit, 10cm long. Heat level 4/10. Use fresh or dried. Ideal for adding spice in sauces, bottling & insecticidal spray.

- **Scotch Bonnet** (*Capsicum chinense*) **AusQual**
Growing to 80cm high. Producing small, red bonnet shaped fruit. Derived from the West Indies. Heat level 8

- **Trinidad Scorpion Cardi** (*Capsicum chinense*) **AusQual**
Popular annual to 1.3m, producing golden fruit. 6cm long. Heat level 10/10. Use fresh or dried. Originates from Trinidad. Ideal for adding spice in sauces, bottling & insecticidal spray

- **Yellow Jelly Bean** (*Capsicum chinense*) **AusQual**
Popular annual to 1m, producing powerful yellow fruit to 1cm long. Heat level 9/10. Use fresh or dried. Ideal for adding spice in sauces, bottling & insecticidal spray.

- **Zimbabwe Birds Eye** (*Capsicum frutescens*) **AusQual**
Grows to 50cm, producing powerful red fruit to 3cm long. Heat level 8/10. Use fresh or dried. Well known in Portugal where it is used to make Piri Piri Sauce. Ideal grower for pots.

CHRYSANTHEMUM - Edible

(*Chrysanthemum coronarium*) **AusQual**
Annual to 1.5 metres, very hardy, eat leaves raw or cooked. Attractive Yellow flowers. Sow anytime.

COLLARD - Georgia Southern (*Brassica oleracea*) **AusQual**
Hardy vegetable that produces large light soft green leaves over a long period. Sweet flavour use fresh or lightly steamed. High in vitamins and minerals. Sow Autumn-Spring.

COWPEA - Edible Giant (*Vigna unguiculata*) **AusQual**
Annual legume spreading to 1.5 metres, mauve flowers. Green pods eaten when young, plants can yield up to 1kg of black seeds. Used cooked as for pulses, soil improver. Sow Spring - Summer.

CORN (*Zea mays*) - **Not to TAS** -
Popular easy to grow. For fertile, well drained soil, sunny position. Pick your own fresh corn. Sow Spring - Summer.

Maize

- **Blue Hopi** **Organic**
Vigorous growth to 2.5m, originating with the Hopi Indians. Young cobs eaten fresh or left to dry for maize flour, blue corn chips, tortillas. Up to 2 cobs per plant.

- **Early Leaming** **AusQual**
Tall heritage variety to 3 metres. Long cob to 25cm, yellow kernels, eaten when young or stock feed.

- **Macleay White** **Organic**
Similar to Maize - Manning White with its growth habit, large cob. A different strain sourced from a farmer in the Macleay Valley NSW.

- **Mandan** **Organic**
Heirloom dating back to the American Indians. Commonly used as a flour maize to make tortillas & flat breads. Kernels dark red, 2 good cobs per plant, height 2 metres.

- **Manning White** **AusQual**
Tall grower to 3 metres, producing 1 large cob of white corn. Eat fresh or use as animal feed. Bred in the Manning Valley 1932.

- **Multi-Coloured Aztec** **Organic**
Medium sized attractive glassy looking cobs with varying coloured kernels. Used for eating when young or grinding into flour.

- **Red Aztec** **Organic**
Large cob with attractive red kernels. Can be eaten fresh when young or dry cob to grind into flour.

- **Silvermine** **Organic**
A rare dent corn used for feed production. Producing 1-2 large 23cm cobs of white corn. Kernels are deep on average 15mm. Strain may have history with Manning Silvermine but it's hard to be certain. Eat cobs roasted at milking stage or for animal feed. Easy to grow. Sunny position. Sow Spring-Summer.

Popcorn

- **Blue Mini** **Organic**
Highly sought after heirloom popcorn variety. Growing to 1.5m they will not take up too much room in your garden. Pop's extremely well. 90 days to maturity.

- **Ontos Oval** **Organic**
Grows to 2 metres high producing numerous small cobs. Kernels white, oval shaped, soft & tender when popped.

- **Strawberry Mini** **AusQual**
Fast growing to 1.2 metres high, producing up to 6 cobs per plant with bright red kernels. Ideal for popcorn or crafty creations.

Sweet Corn

- **Anasazi** **AusQual**
Ancient multi-coloured sweet corn. Derived from the Anasazi Indians in America. Beautiful eating corn. Maturity 90 days. Rare.

- **Balinese** **AusQual**
Strong grower to 3m, producing 2 good sized yellow cobs per plant. Harvest young for good flavour. 110 days to maturity.

- **Country Gentleman** **Organic**
Sweet corn yields 2-3 18cm cobs that have white kernels, irregular arrangement and a sweet flavour. Holds sweetness at eating stage longer than most other heirloom varieties and maintains it's texture when cooked.

- **Golden Bantam** **AusQual**
Popular variety producing up to 2 yellow cobs per plant, early maturing 70-80 days. Good flavour.

- **Hawaiian** **AusQual**
Compact grower to 1.5m. Produces 2 good sized delicious yellow cobs. Good flavour. 100 days to maturity.

- **Jolly Roger** **Organic**
Excellent Australian bred sweet corn producing up to two yellow cobs per plant. Grows to 2.5m tall.

CUCUMBER (*Cucumis sativus*)

Summer salad vegetable likes rich well watered soil. Sow Spring - Summer.

- **African Horned** (*Cucumis metuliferus*) **AusQual**
Fruit 15cm long, spiny skin, orange at maturity. Sweet green jelly-like flesh inside. Four times the Vitamin C of oranges.

- **German Pickling** **Organic**
Compact spreading vine, producing yellow tinged fruit, pick at 20cm. Juicy and crisp eaten fresh, pick at young stage for pickling.

- **Giant Russian** **AusQual**
Vigorous mildew resistant variety, acid free. Crisp sweet flesh, eat at 20cm long. Good keeper.

- **Lebanese** **AusQual**
Compact bush variety. Fruit picked at 20cm, green colour, good flavour, non acid. For home gardens and commercial growers.

- **Long White** **AusQual**
Long white fruit to 18 cm, very tasty. Early season variety. Non-acid.

- **Marketmore** **Organic**
Popular variety. Flavoured green fruit to 25cm long. Good producer.

- **White Spine** **AusQual**
Smooth white skin, oblong fruit to 15cm. Good flavour, excellent eating.

- **West Indian Gherkin** (*Cucumis anguria*) **AusQual**
Produces green 5 cm diameter fruits, soft spines on outside, sweet and juicy when young. Used for pickling. Eat fresh.

EGGPLANT (*Solanum melongena*)

Attractive leaves and flowers. Fruit used in cooked dishes. Sow Spring-Summer. Likes fertile well drained soil in sunny position

- **Black Beauty** **AusQual**
Decorative annual, attractive leaves and flowers. Fruit used in cooking. Large oval black fruit. Sow Spring-Summer.

- **Long Purple** **Organic**
Popular variety, producing long dark fruit to 25cm long and 8cm wide. Good cropper.

- **Thai Pea (*Solanum torvum*)** **AusQual**
Shrubby plant, perennial to 90cm high & wide. Branching habit, green pea sized berries produced in clusters, have a slightly bitter taste. Used in Thai dishes. Frost tender, sow Spring-Summer.
- **Rosa Bianca** **AusQual**
Rose colored round fruits with paler stripes. Good sweet flavour, no bitterness. Attractive leaves and flowers. Fruits used in cooked dishes. Sow Spring-Summer.
- ▶ **ENDIVE - Pancalieri Fine Cut (*Cichorium endivia*)** **AusQual**
Attractive large lacy fine cut leaves with crispy ribs and creamy heart. Use in salad with other leafy greens. Excellent microgreen plant. Likes good well drained soil, sunny position. Winter hardy. Sow Autumn-Spring.
- GOURD (*Lagenaria siceraria*)**
Eaten like squash & zucchini when picked young. Many shaped fruits. Dried fruits can be decorated and used for bowls and musical instruments. Sow Spring-Summer.
 - **Ancient** **AusQual**
Vigorous vine, provide large support to climb on. Large trombone shape fruit.
 - **Large Mixed** **AusQual**
Vigorous vine, as above. Large white flowers.
 - **New Guinea** **AusQual**
Also known as New Guinea bean. Annual vine grown on fence or ground. Long smooth, pale green fruits to 1.3 metres long. Harvest fruits at 20cm & use like zucchini. Used in Indian & Asian dishes.
 - **Snake (*Trichosanthes anguina*)** **AusQual**
Vigorous climbing annual. Mature fruit to 1 metre long with decorative hard shell.
- KALE - Black Magic (*Brassica oleracea*)** **AusQual**
Improved Tuscan variety. Produces long dark green leaves that have a savoyed look, formed from the middle of the plant. Highly nutritious. Sweet flavour. Eaten fresh or steamed. Sow Autumn-Winter.
- KALE - Red Russian (*Brassica oleracea*)** **Organic**
Leaves blue-green with purplish red veins. Sweet flavour, eaten fresh when young or steamed. Hardy to grow. Sow Autumn-Winter.
- ▶ **KALE - Scarlet (*Brassica oleracea*)** **AusQual**
Attractive curly leafed red kale with tasty frilly leaves. Harvest young leaves regularly for use in salads and stir fries. Can also be grown as an ornamental display plant. Sow Autumn-Winter.

- LETTUCE (*Lactuca sativa*)**
Hearting and Loose leaf types, decorative colours and shapes. For Cool/Cold climates sow Spring-Autumn. All other climates sow Autumn-Spring. Varieties available for all seasons, plant in rich well drained soil, sunny moist position.
 - **Australian Yellow** **AusQual**
Wavy loose leaf head with yellowish green glow in colour.
 - **Brown Romaine** **AusQual**

An annual vine producing small green oval fruit to 4cm long. Has a typical crunchy cucumber taste with some sourness. Sweetens with age. Native to Mexico, heavy producer. Use in salads, pickles or dessert. Sow Spring-Summer.
- MUSTARD (*Brassica juncea*)**
Attractive plant with flavoured leaves when eaten fresh in salads. Good in stir-fries. Sow Autumn - Spring.
 - **Osaka Purple (*Brassica juncea rugosa*)** **AusQual**
Leaves large, round, greenish purple with a darker edge. Mild mustard flavour.
 - **Red Giant** **AusQual**
Produces large, peppery flavoured, red-purple leaves. Not hot when cooked.

- **Ruby Streaks (*Brassica japonica*)** **AusQual**
