# Vegetables

## AMARANTH - Grain

(*Amaranthus hypochondriacus*)

OGA

Annual versatile plant, leaves rich in vitamins and minerals. Low in oxalic acid, eat in salads or cooked. Seeds are white, high in protein, can be popped. Sow Spring-Summer.

## AMARANTH - Leaf (*Amaranthus gangeticus*)

OGA

Annual, grows to 1.5 metres, leaves and stems used like spinach. Sow Spring-Summer. High in protein, vitamins and minerals.

## ARTICHOKE - Globe (*Cynara scolymus*)

OGA

Grows to 1.5 metres, a prized delicacy. Used steamed, casseroles and preserves. Fast growing, likes rich well drained soil. Sow Autumn, Winter, Spring.

## BEANS - BUSH (*Phaseolus vulgaris*)

High yielding and rich in protein. Plant every 3 weeks for continuous supply. Sow Spring-Summer.

### NEW Blue Lake

Organic

Popular standard variety bush to 50cm high. 15cm green pods with good flavour..

### - Brown Beauty

OGA

Old variety, french strain, disease resistant.

### - Butter Bush

OGA

Compact grower to 45cm, producing crop of yellow pods, black seed, stringless when picked young, good flavour.

### - Hawkesbury Wonder

OGA

Popular old stringless variety, produces over a long period, green pods to 15cm long.

### NEW Prestons

OGA

Old variety producing tasty, round green pods over a long period. Bushy plant to 45cm.

### NEW Provider

Organic

Popular bush variety producing purple flowers, green round stringless pods to 15cm long.

### NEW Rocard

Organic

Slender pods on compact bush, French bean type. Attractive yellow pods to 15cm long.

## BEAN - CLIMBING (*Phaseolus vulgaris*)

Take up little room and yield over a long period, provide trellis. Sow Spring-Summer.

### - Delgado Black Mexican

Organic

Climber to 2 metres, green pods, black seeds. Mature seeds used as dry bean, also useful as black dye.

### NEW Epicure

OGA

Popular old variety. Long flat green pods to 20cms. Stringless when young, bears over a long period.

### NEW Fredrico

Organic

Strong grower to 2 metre. Green stringless, good yields over a long period.

### - Greek Bean

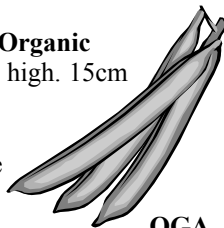
OGA

Strong growing variety, producing good crop of flat green, stringless pods to 15cm long.

### - Kentucky Wonder

OGA

Vigorous grower, producing green, fleshy, flat pods. Stringless when young to 20cm, rust resistant.



## NEW Lablab (*Dolichochoch lablab*)

OGA

Vigorous perennial in warm climates to 2.5 metres. Pods eaten steamed or boiled when young. Black seeds, excellent legume, ground cover & soil improver.

### - Madagascar (*Phaseolus lunatus*)

OGA

Perennial climber to 2 metres, wiry growth with red & white coloured seeds. Young pods steamed and seeds used as a dry soup bean when mature.

## NEW Northeast

Organic

Continental European variety, flat green pods to 20cm long and 2cms wide. Early maturing climber to 2 metres.

### - Purple King

OGA

Flat purple pod to 18cm popular variety. Pods turn green when cooked. Adds colour and flavour to salads.

### - Rice

OGA

Spreading type, can climb, covers 1m2. Young green pods sweet tasty. Excellent nitrogen fixer, green manure. Perennial in warmer climates, excellent for soil improver.

### - Snake Bean

-Not to WA-

OGA

Strong grower, yields 45 cm long pods, eat fresh or cooked.

## NEW Wellington Wonder

OGA

Flat green pods to 20cm. Prolific cropping, good flavour. Climbs to 2 metres.

### - Zebra

OGA

Stringless when picked young, strong grower, old variety.

## BETROOT (*Beta vulgaris*)

Popular root vegetable, fast growing, bi-annual, easy to grow. Sow direct in garden, 60 days to maturity. Keep moist in fertile well drained soil. Use in salads, cooked or preserved. Sow all year except in hot weather.

## NEW Bulls Blood

Organic

Attractive dark red leaves. Used in salads and cooked foods. Good flavour, dark red zoned root.

## NEW Chiogga

Organic

Also known as Candy Stripe. Attractive red skinned beetroot with red & white rings.

## NEW Detroit - Golden

Organic

Sweet golden colour, use tops as spinach. Good flavour and no staining.

## NEW Detroit - Red

Organic

Round red roots up to 12cm across. Smooth, tender, sweet flavour.

## NEW Early Wonder Top

Organic

Produces tall leafy tops, excellent greens, Attractive red root with colour zones.

## BOK CHOY - Chinese Cabbage (*Brassica species*)

Organic

Annual loose-leaf cabbage, with lime green succulent leaves and white crunchy stems. Harvest large leaves over a long period. Sow Autumn-Spring.

## BROCCOLI (*Brassica oleracea*)

Rich in calcium, vitamins and minerals. Sow all year.

### - Albert

Organic

Compact plant, dark green large heads.

### - DiCicco

Organic

Compact Italian variety. Blue-green heads to 10cm across, produces over a long period. Harvest at 60 days.

### CABBAGE (*Brassica oleracea*)

Popular vegetable, high in calcium and iron. Likes fertile well drained soil, sunny position, frost hardy. Sow all year, except hot conditions.

- NEW Golden Acre** **Organic**  
Early producing variety, forming small light green heads to 1.5kg. 80 days to maturity.
- Red** **Organic**  
Medium sized. Adds attractive colour to salads.

### CAPSICUM (*Capsicum annuum*)

Popular Summer vegetable, high yielding, shrubby plants for warm sunny position. Yield over a long period. Sow Spring - Summer

- Californian Wonder** **Organic**  
Sweet fruit, cube shaped 10 cm, bell type, heavy producer use green or red, high in Vitamin C.
- NEW Golden Californian Wonder** **Organic**  
Sweet capsicum to 10cm, block shape, fruit green ripening to yellow-orange. Adds colour to salads and cooked dishes.

### CARROT (*Daucus carota*)

Popular root vegetable, for deep well drained soil, sunny position. Do not over feed, keep moist. Sow All Year.

- Chantenay Red Cored** **OGA**  
Short roots to 12cm, orange red colour. Ideal for shallow soils.
- NEW Danvers** **Organic**  
Hardy variety to suit most soils. Slender, deep orange to 15cm, tolerates hot conditions. Eat fresh. Suited to freezing.
- King West** **Organic**  
Long succulent orange roots to 20cm or more.
- NEW Little Finger** **Organic**  
Tasty baby gourmet carrot to 10cm long. Orange, cylindrical roots.
- Scarlet Nantes** **Organic**  
Bright orange-red root to 18cm, coreless variety. Very sweet flavour. Good for juicing and baby carrots.
- Western Red** **OGA**  
Long tapering root, smooth deep orange colour. Disease resistant. 70 days to maturity.

### CAULIFLOWER - Snowball (*Brassica oleracea*) **Organic**

Produces white heads to 15cm across. Suited to warmer climates. Sow Autumn-Winter.

### CELERY (*Apium graveolens var dulce*) **Sow Autumn-Spring.**

- Chinese (*Brassica juncea*)** **OGA**  
Grows to 60 cm, with large spicy flavoured leaves, 3-4 cm wide midrib & tapered at the end. Midrib is crunchy, juicy & sweet, can be eaten fresh or cooked.
- NEW Tall Utah** **Organic**  
Dark green stringless stems to 70cm.
- Tendercrisp** **OGA**  
Likes rich well drained soil and ample water. Green smooth stringless, very hardy.

### CHIA (*Salvia rhyacophila*) **OGA**

Hardy annual to 1.5 metres, leaves used in salads, seeds for sprouts. Seeds rich in vitamins and protein, forage plant. Whole plant regarded as survival food. Sow Spring-Summer.

### CHILLI (*Capsicum annuum*)

Hardy Summer vegetable, high yielding. Adds flavour to cooked dishes. Ideal for bottling. Sow Spring-Summer, plant in good, well drained soil in sunny position. Sow Spring - Summer.

- NEW Cayenne** **Organic**  
Slender green fruit, maturing to red.
- Jalapeno Chilli** **Organic**  
Popular variety, fruit red or green, hot, 8 cm long, thick flesh, original Mexican chillies.

### CHRYSANTHEMUM - Edible

#### (*Chrysanthemum coronarium*) **OGA**

Annual to 1.5 metres, very hardy, eat leaves raw or cooked. Attractive Yellow flowers. Sow anytime.

### COWPEA - Edible Giant (*Vigna unguiculata*) **Not WA** **OGA**

Annual legume spreading to 1.5 metres, mauve flowers. Green pods eaten when young, plants can yield up to 1kg of black seeds. Used cooked as for pulses, soil improver. Sow Spring - Summer.

### CORN (*Zea mays*) **-Not to WA & TAS-**

Popular easy to grow. For fertile, well drained soil, sunny position. Pick your own fresh corn. Sow Spring - Summer.

- Maize - Early Leaming** **OGA**  
Tall heritage variety to 3 metres. Long cob to 25cm, yellow kernels, eaten when young.
- Sweet Corn - Golden Bantam** **OGA**  
Popular variety producing up to 2 cobs per plant, early maturing 70-80 days. Good flavour.
- Sweet Corn - Hawaiian** **OGA**  
Compact grower to 1.5 metres. Produces 2 good sized delicious cobs. Good flavour. 100 days to maturity.

### CUCUMBER (*Cucumis sativus*)

Summer salad vegetable likes rich well watered soil. Sow Spring - Summer.

- African Horned (*Cucumis metuliferus*)** **-Not WA-** **OGA**  
Fruit 15cm long, spiny skin, orange at maturity. Sweet green jelly-like flesh inside. Four times the Vitamin C of oranges.
- NEW Armenian (*Cucumis melo*)** **Organic**  
Light green, ribbed fruit up to 70cm long. Burpless variety with thin skin. Mild flavour, good producer..

- German Pickling** **Organic**  
Compact spreading vine, producing yellow tinged fruit, pick at 20cm. Juicy and crisp eaten fresh, pick at young stage for pickling.
- Giant Russian** **OGA**  
Vigorous mildew resistant variety, acid free. Crisp sweet flesh, eat at 20cm long. Good keeper.
- Green Gem** **OGA**  
Good slicing variety, fruit dark green to 20 cm long, white flesh and mildew resistant.

- Lebanese** **Organic**  
Compact bush variety. Fruit picked at 20cm, green colour, good flavour, non acid. For home gardens and commercial growers.

- Long White** **OGA**  
Long white fruit to 18 cm, very tasty. Early season variety. Non-acid.



**NEW** Marketmore **Organic**  
Popular variety. Flavoured green fruit to 25cm long. Good producer.

- **White Spine** **Organic**  
Smooth white skin, oblong fruit to 15cm. Good flavour, excellent eating.

- **West Indian Gherkin (*Cucumis anguria*)** **Not WA** **OGA**  
Produces green 5 cm diameter fruits, soft spines on outside, sweet and juicy when young. Used for pickling. Eat fresh.



**EGGPLANT (*Solanum melongena*)**  
Attractive leaves and flowers. Fruit used in cooked dishes. Sow Spring-Summer. Likes fertile well drained soil in sunny position

- **Black Beauty** **Organic**  
Decorative annual, attractive leaves and flowers. Fruit used in cooking. Large oval black fruit. Sow Spring-Summer.

**NEW** Long Purple **Organic**  
Popular variety, producing long dark fruit to 25cm long and 8cm wide. Good cropper.

**NEW** Rosa Bianca **Organic**  
Rose coloured fruit with paler stripes. Good sweet flavour, no bitterness.

**GOURD (*Lagenaria siceraria*)**  
Eaten like squash & zucchini when picked young. Many shaped fruits. Dried fruits can be decorated and used for bowls and musical instruments. Sow Spring.

- **Ancient** **OGA**  
Vigorous vine, provide large support to climb on. Large trombone shape fruit.

- **Large Mixed** **OGA**  
Vigorous vine, as above. Large white flowers.

- **Miniature** **Organic**  
Compact climber to 2 metres, producing numerous fruit 6cm across to 8cm long, tapering to a neck. Green & yellow in colour, drying to brown. Ornamental uses.

- **Snake (*Trichosanthes anguina*)** **Organic**  
Vigorous climbing annual. Mature fruit to 1 metre long with decorative hard shell.

**KALE - Red Russian (*Brassica oleracea*)** **Organic**  
Leaves blue-green with purplish red veins. Sweet flavour, eaten fresh when young or steamed. Hardy to grow. Sow Autumn-Winter.

**KOHLRABI - Purple Vienna (*Brassica oleracea Gongylodes*)** **Organic**  
Delicious root vegetable, bulb & purple stem. Eaten when young 6cm across. Steam or boil. Leaves also used when young. Sow Autumn-Spring.

**LEEK - Autumn Giant (*Allium ampeloprasum porrum*)** **OGA**  
Larger variety with longer stem. Great steamed, baked, fried for garnish, boiled, blends well with other vegetables. Adds flavour to soups & quiches. Likes deep, fertile, moist soil. Sow Autumn - Winter.

**NEW** LEEK - Musselburgh (*Allium ampeloprasum porrum*) **Organic**  
Old variety, good standard blue-green leaves. Medium grower. Sow Autumn - Winter.

**LETTUCE (*Lactuca sativa*)**  
Hearting and Loose leaf types, decorative colours and shapes. For Cool/Cold climates sow Spring-Autumn. All other climates sow Autumn-Spring. Varieties available for all seasons, plant in rich well drained soil, sunny moist position.

- **Australian Yellow** **OGA**  
Wavy loose leaf head with yellowish green glow in colour.



**NEW** Buttercrunch **Organic**  
Small dark green, crisp head, fan shaped leaves, heat resistant.

- **Brown Romaine** **Organic**  
Loose leaf type, green and brown tinged, heat resistant.

- **Cos Verdi** **OGA**  
Open, upright hearting variety, crisp leaves with smooth edges, unique sweet taste.

- **Everlasting** **OGA**  
Loose leaf type, leaves are light green and dissected.

- **Freckles** **OGA**  
Green cos with striking red splashes throughout.

- **Frilly Pink** **OGA**  
Non-hearting, open leaf type. Large green leaves with attractive pink edges.

- **Green Mignonette** **OGA**  
Popular compact hearting variety. Soft green leaves with sweet flavour.

- **Green Oak** **OGA**  
Green open leaf type. Leaves are oak shaped.

- **Loose Leaf** **OGA**  
Open leaf type, light green & frilly. Pick leaves as required.

- **Purple Oak** **Organic**  
Purple tinged loose leaf with oak shaped leaves.

- **Rabbit Ear** **OGA**  
Upright soft green leaves. Loose leaf type.

- **Red Mignonette** **OGA**  
Compact hearting variety. Soft red/brown leaves with a sweet flavour.

- **Red Oak Leaf** **OGA**  
Annual leafy green to 30cm, non-hearting. Leaves red tinged and dissected.

- **Ricciolina da Taglio** **OGA**  
Large loose leaf with deeply lobed curly green leaves.

- **Side Pick** **OGA**  
Frilly green dissected leaves. Light green colour. Highly decorative loose leaf type.

**NEW** Simpson **Organic**  
Large frilly, light green leaves, sweet tasting. Pick leaves as required.

**LUFFA (*Luffa aegyptiaca*)** **OGA**  
Train on trellis, large yellow flowers. Bathroom sponge and scrubber. Eat like marrow when young. Sow after frost.

**MESCLUN MIX** **Organic**  
A mixture of leafy greens, including lettuce (green & red types), mizuna and pak choi.

**MIBUNA (*Brassica japonica*)** **Organic**  
Long leaves and narrow stem, soft green colour. Young leaves and stems eaten fresh or cooked. Sow Autumn and Winter.

**MIZUNA (*Brassica juncea*)** **OGA**  
Japanese salad plant, vigorous and very hardy, mild mustard flavour. Sow Autumn and Winter.

**MUSTARD - Osaka Purple (*Brassica juncea rugosa*)** Organic  
Leaves large, round, greenish purple with a darker edge. Mild mustard flavour for salads and stir-fries. Sow Autumn - Spring.

**MUSTARD - Red Giant (*Brassica juncea*)** OGA  
Produces large red-purple leaves. Attractive plant with peppery flavoured leaves when eaten fresh in salads. Not hot when cooked. Good in stir-fries. Sow Autumn - Spring.

**OKRA - Clemsons Spineless (*Abelmoschus esculentus*)** OGA  
Quick growing Summer vegetable, annual to 1 metre. Immature fruits eaten steamed & cooked - a real delicacy. Sow Spring-Summer.

**OKRA - Burgundy (*Abelmoschus esculentus*)** OGA  
Attractive red pods. Good producer to 1 metre. Tolerates cooler conditions. Holds colour after cooking. Sow Spring - Summer.

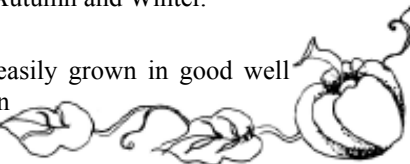
**ORACH - Green (*Atriplex hortensis*)** OGA  
A hardy Summer annual producing green leaves. Used as spinach or for salads. Can tolerate coastal soils, withstands dry conditions. Sow Spring - Autumn.

**PAK CHOI (*Brassica parachinensis*)** OGA  
Compact fast growing, loose leaf cabbage, with thick, crisp, succulent stalks. Leaves form a dense clump. Use fresh or in stir-fries. Sow Autumn-Spring.

**PARSNIP - Hollow Crown (*Pastinaca sativa*)** OGA  
Hardy root vegetable, likes cool weather, frost hardy. Long white pointed root. Sow Autumn and Winter.

**PUMPKIN (*Cucurbita*)**

Annual bushes or vines easily grown in good well drained soil. Used in soups, pies and baking. Sow Spring and Summer.



**-Baby Blue (*C. maxima*)** OGA  
Compact bush variety, blue-grey skin, orange flesh, fruit to 15cm across. Popular dry pumpkin, good keeper.

**- Golden Nugget (*C. maxima*)** OGA  
Very compact bush, orange fruit matures in 3 months and weighs up to 1 kg. Used in soup, baked or steamed.

**- Gramma Trombone (*C. moschata*)** OGA  
Popular old variety, fruit to 60cm long. Moist deep orange flesh with good flavour.

**- Jap (*C. moschata*)** Organic  
Popular variety, squat fruit with yellow-orange flesh. Excellent flavour.

**- Queensland Blue (*C. maxima*)** Organic  
Popular variety, good keeper, orange flesh.

**- Waltham Butternut (*C. moschata*)** Organic  
Pear-shaped fruit to 2kg with light orange skin. Small seed cavity at one end. Orange coloured flesh, dry and tasty.

**RADISH (*Raphanus sativus*)**

**NEW Black Spanish Round** Organic  
Black skinned, crisp white flesh. Globe shaped root.

**- Cherry Belle** Organic  
Smooth round red root to 4cm across. White mild flesh. 30-40 days to maturity.

**- Daikon** OGA  
Japanese variety. Long white round root, mild flavour in winter, grows all year. Use fresh, in stir-fry. Breaks up soil, good cover crop, produces bulk organic matter. Self sows.

**NEW French Breakfast** Organic  
Scarlet roots with white rounded tip to 8cm, mild flavour.

**RHUBARB - Sydney Crimson (*Rheum rhabarbarum*)** OGA  
Hardy perennial to 50cm. Grown for the stems. Strong red colour, excellent home garden variety and markets. Making of jams, and pies. Sow Spring - Autumn.

**ROCKMELON (*Cucumis melo*)**  
Summer fruit with sweet edible flesh. Sow Spring - Summer.

**- Hales Best** Organic  
Popular variety, sweet juicy orange flesh, delicious flavour, mildew resistant.

**- Honey Dew** Organic  
Smooth white skinned, sweet green flesh. High sugar content. 100 days to maturity.

**- Planters Jumbo** OGA  
Large oval shaped fruit produced on vigorous vines in Summer. Fruit contains sweet orange, edible flesh.

**SALSIFY (*Tragopogon porrifolius*)** Organic  
Biannual to 1 metre. Ancient vegetable, producing long fleshy roots, can be baked, boiled, fried or stewed. Sow Spring - Autumn.

**SHALLOTS (*Allium fistulosum*)** Organic  
Perennial variety to 50 cm, straight leaf with a good sized base. Ideal for salads and cooking. Sow Autumn-Spring.

**SILVERBEET (*Beta vulgaris*)**  
Popular vegetable. Use steamed, cooked & fresh. Likes fertile, well drained, moist soil. Sun to part shade. Sow Autumn-Spring.

**- Fordhook** Organic  
Light green leaves to 60cm high, whites stalks, popular variety. Sow Autumn - Spring.

**NEW Rainbow Chard** Organic  
Attractive nutritious vegetable, stems red, white & yellow. Leaves green. Use as for silverbeet.

**- Ruby Red Chard** Organic  
Colourful spinach-like plant with red stems and dark green leaves. Attractive garden plant, used as silverbeet.

**SPINACH (*Spinacia oleracea*)**  
Rich source of vitamins and minerals, eat fresh or steamed. Sow Autumn & Winter.

**- Ceylon (*Basella alba*)** OGA  
Summer climbing or trailing spinach to 1.5 metres. Thick, tasty leaves, rich in chlorophyll. Use in salads, cooking, soups. Perennial in warm climates, annual in cool climates. Sow Spring-Summer.

**NEW English Bloomsdale** Organic  
Produces broad dark green leaves, heavy yielding, good home garden & market garden variety. Withstands heat & cold. Sow Autumn-Spring.

**- Southern European** OGA  
Large leaves like silverbeet, but sweeter

### Green Manure:

The varieties listed below have many uses in providing mulch, nitrogen fixation to the soil, organic matter, which can be slashed or turned in, and also providing a broad range of nutrients. These varieties have many other uses and are stated as such. Legumes can be sown on their own or with existing vegetation, or grown with grass and grain species as listed below. We recommend with low fertility soils that some type of nutrients be added initially in an organic form to help the green manure along. Grasses and grains can be grown on their own if fertility is good, thus providing bulk organic matter when slashed.

**GREEN MANURE MIX** Organic  
A mix of seeds for specific seasons. This mix provides variety in your green manure. Specify season; Autumn/Winter - Oats, Vetch, Barley mix. Spring/Summer - Mungbean, Soybean & Millet. 500g will cover 30m<sup>2</sup>.

### Legumes:

**CHICKPEA (*Cicer arietinum*)** BFA  
Annual legume to 60cm, excellent green manure. Seeds used whole, mashed, roasted, soups, thick paste, sprouts or flour. Sow Autumn - Winter. 1kg will cover 60m<sup>2</sup>

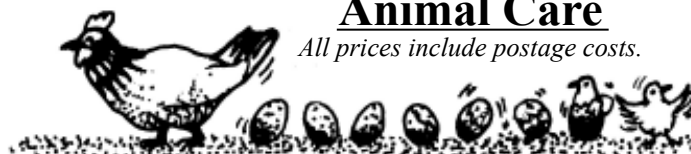

Annual spreading vine, fruits cylindrical to 35cm, producing yellow spaghetti like flesh. Excellent baked or boiled. Internal flesh scraped out and served with sauce. Sow Spring - Summer.

**SUGARBEET** (*Beta vulgaris crassa*)

Hardy biennial produces a large storage root, high in sucrose. Excellent fodder crop. Sow Autumn - Spring.

**TATSOI** (*Brassica rapa rosularis*)

Compact plant to 30cm high, produces small, dark green, spoon shaped leaves in a whirl. Harvest in 30 days, mild flavour. Use in salads & lightly cooked. Sow Autumn - Spring.

**WATERMELON** (*Citrullus vulgaris*)

Grown in Spring - Summer. Plant in fertile well drained soil, water well, eat fresh or juiced.

**- Charleston Grey**

Oblong fruit to 60cm long x 25cm wide. Thick gray-green rind with darker veins. Bright red, sweet flesh up to 15kg.

**- Jam**

Fruit smooth, round, pale yellow flesh. Good bearers, makes good jam.

**- Sugarbaby**

Small round fruit to 4kg, excellent bright red flesh, dark green skin. Tolerates cooler conditions.

**ZUCCHINI - Ronde de Nice** (*Cucurbita pepo*)

Compact bush variety producing small, round, light green fruit, delicious flavour. Use steamed or baked. Sow Spring - Summer.

**ANISE HYSSOP** (*Agastache foeniculum*)

Perennial to 1m, member of the mint family, leaves have anise flavour. Used for tea, pot-pori. Bee plant. Sow Spring - Autumn.

**BASIL** (*Ocimum basilicum*)

Popular herb, used in salads and cooked foods fresh or dried.

Sow Spring - Summer.

**NEW** - **Dark Opal** (*Ocimum basilicum purpurea*)

Attractive annual bush to 45cm, with dark red/purple leaves, ornamental plant with lilac flowers and a mild scent. Use as a garnish, colour salads, vinegars, etc.

**Lime** (*Ocimum basilicum citriodorum*)

Grows to 60cm high producing bright green leaves with a tangy lime-lemon flavour. Flowers attractive pink.

**5gm = \$8**

**- Siam Queen** (*Ocimum basilicum purpurea*)

Attractive growing Thai basil with green leaves and intense licorice - basil aroma with red flowers, compact grower.

**- Thai**

Annual to 60cm high, Flowers purple, green leaves and red stems. Used to flavour curry dishes and spicy cooking.

**5gm = \$8; 25gm = \$25; 50gm = \$40**

**CARRAWAY** (*Carum carvi*)

Biennial to 60cm. Seeds used in cakes and biscuits, edible root and medicinal uses. Sow Spring-Autumn.

**CHERVIL** (*Anthriscus cerefolium*)

Culinary herb, annual to 60cm with finely cut soft leaves. Mild licorice-like flavour. Use fresh or in cooked dishes. Sow all year.

**CHIVES Not to TAS** (*Allium tuberosum*)

Perennial to 90cm, flat green leaves, white flowers, onion and garlic flavour. Use fresh or in cooking. Sow anytime.

**CORIANDER** (*Coriandrum sativum*)

Annual to 60cm, white flowers, leaves used in cooking and salads, seeds add flavour to baking. Sow Spring-Summer.

**NEW** **CUMIN** (*Cuminum cyminum*)

Hardy biennial to 40cm high. Cream coloured flowers, seeds used to flavour many cooked dishes. Sow Spring-Autumn.

**NEW** **DANDELION** (*Taraxacum officinale*)

High in vitamin A and minerals. Produces tender dark green leaves. Use as a vegetable, steam leaves, roots ground and roasted for coffee substitute. Sow all year.

**FENNEL**

Attractive annual with feathery leaves. Use seeds, flowers and leaves in biscuits, cakes, cooking or fresh salads.

**- Florence** (*Foeniculum dulce*)

Annual to 1 metre, edible swollen stems, anise flavoured, likes rich soil. Sow Autumn - Spring.

**- Sweet** (*Foeniculum officinale*)

Annual to 1.5 metres, green leaves, yellow flowers.

Sow all year. **25gm = \$7; 50gm = \$12; 100gm = \$22**

**LEMON BALM** (*Melissa officinalis*)

Perennial to 80 cm, lemon scented, leaves used in salads, cooking & herbal teas. Sow all year.

**NEW** **LOVAGE** (*Levisticum officinale*)

Perennial herb, dormant in cooler months, producing aromatic leaves. Slightly spicy and celery like flavour. Use in casseroles, stews and stir-frys. Sow Spring-Summer.

**OREGANO** (*Origanum vulgare*)

Perennial ground cover to 60cm, very hardy, pink flowers in Autumn. Aromatic foliage and flowers, used dry or fresh in cooked dishes, pizza, casseroles, tomato and meat. Can be grown in pots or garden, sunny spot. Sow Spring - Autumn.

**PARSLEY - Hamburg** (*Petroselinum crispum tuberosum*)

A variety of root parsley that produces white tapered roots to 25cm long. Steamed or baked. Deeply cut leaves used as other parsley.

**STINGING NETTLE** (*Urtica dioica*)

Upright grower to 90cm high. Perennial, easily grown, young shots cooked like spinach. Used dried or cooked, high in protein. Sow Autumn - Spring.

**SUMMER SAVOURY** (*Satureja hortensis*)  
Annual to 60cm producing aromatic leaves with excellent flavour. Use dried or fresh in bean, meat & fish dishes. Sow Spring - Autumn. **25gm = \$8; 50gm = \$14**

**WORMWOOD** (*Artemisia absinthium*)  
Hardy perennial shrub to 80cm high with grey-green, finely cut leaves. Highly pungent fragrance used to repel insects. Yellow flowers in Summer.

**LARKSPUR - Mixed** (*Delphinium consolida*)  
Annual to 1.2 metres, mix of coloured flowers produced on long spike. Useful cut flower, very showy display. Sow Autumn-Winter.

**PETUNIA - Mixed Colours** (*Petunia nana compacta*)  
Colourful annual flowers to 5cm across. For sunny position, tolerates hot conditions. Sow Spring - Summer. **5gm = \$8**

**POPPY**  
Annual to 60cm. Sow Autumn - Spring.  
**- Californian** (*Eschscholzia californica*)  
Annual to 60cm for sunny position, producing vibrant display of tulip like flowers in mixed colours. **5gm = \$7**

**POPPY - Flanders** (*Papaver rhoeas*)  
Spectacular flowering poppy. Flowers large to 9cm across, in bright red & orange with dark centre. **5gm = \$7; 25gm = \$22**

**PORTULACA - Mixed Colours** (*Portulaca grandiflora*)  
Hardy sun loving annual producing flowers to 5cm across in a brilliant colour range. Height to 20cm. Sow Spring - Summer.



# Sprouts for Health

**Why Sprout?** - for better improved health, high nutritional value, including vitamins A, B, C, D, E & K, plus minerals such as iron, calcium, magnesium, silicon, zinc and protein essential for wellbeing. Sprouts are living food - that is they are growing all the time, fresh and easy to do. It's a quick way of growing without digging - plus kids love them!

**Seeds to use** - Seeds need to be fresh with no chemicals on them. Some seeds for sprouting are Alfalfa, Adzuki, Barley, Broccoli, Buckwheat (unhulled), Fenugreek, Lentils, Millet (unhulled), Mungbean, Mustard Lettuce, Rye, Sunflower (unhulled) and Wheat.

**Containers** - For sprouting on a home scale one can use sprouting jars, colanders lined with flyscreen mesh and also clothes baskets for much larger quantities, seedling tray, wooden box with mesh attached underneath.

## SPROUTING METHODS

**Jar/Colander** - Soak the seeds in jars for 24 hours or until they have at least doubled in size. Cover top of jar with mesh and elastic band to hold seed into place, allow to drain by turning jar to an angle. If using a colander place soaked seeds on the mesh, spreading out evenly. They will generally need rinsing 2-3 times per day. Initially keep the sprouts in an airy cupboard away from light. After sprouting, the grain sprouts can be left near indirect sunlight or in a bright place to green up the shoots. Legume types can be left in the cupboard, eg, Alfalfa, Lentils, Mung and Adzuki beans. Using clean/filtered water for rinsing is the optimum. Most varieties are ready to eat between 3-5 days.

**Tray** - use soil with compost to cover a seed tray 2-3 cm deep, sow seed on top, then cover seed lightly with soil. Water well. Place tray in a warm position, keep damp. If weather allows, seed can be sown direct in the garden as an alternative growing area. Sow seed thick. Ready to eat between 8-12 days.

**Taste as you go** - because sprouts grow each day, it is a good idea to do taste trials daily, to find a taste to suit you and your cooking style.

**USES** - In salads, desserts, breads, cakes, entrees, stirfrys, casseroles, bakes dishes, soups.

**AMOUNT OF SEEDS USED** - 1 tablespoon to ½ cup, depending on the seed variety used.

**TEMPERATURE** 15°-25°C - Seeds sprout easily. For temperatures above 25°C more rinsing is recommended.

**OTHER RECOMMENDED SPROUTS** - Cabbage, Onion & Radish.

1kg Wheat seed will give you 18 standard sprout punnets of food.

1kg Alfalfa seed will give you 60 standard sprout punnets of food.
