AMARANTH (*Amaranthus mangostanus*)
- Edible Green Leaf 5gm - \$8; 25gm - \$20

Growing to 80cm, produces large tender leaves. Use as for spinach and stir fries. Harvest at 30days. Sow Spring-Summer.

ARTICHOKE - Purple Headed (*Cynara scolymus*)

Grows to 1.5 metres, a prized delicacy, used steamed, in casseroles & preserves. Rounded heads purple-green colour, producing large hearts for eating. Grow in rich well drained moist soil. Sow Autumn-Spring 5gm - \$9



ASPARAGUS - Mary Washington (*Asparagus officinalis*)
Perennial to 2 metres, old variety, robust spears, used commercially. Start harvesting after 2 years. Sow Spring - Autumn. 25gm - \$12; 50gm - \$22

ASPARAGUS - Argenteuil (*Asparagus officinalis*)
Attractive French heirloom perennial, 2cm thick white green spears with purple tinted tip. Sow Spring-Autumn.

BEAN - BUSH (*Phaseolus vulgaris*)
High yielding and rich in protein. Plant every 3 weeks for continuous supply. Sow Spring-Summer.

- Cherokee Wax 500gm - \$12; 1kg - \$20

Compact variety producing yellow stringless pods. Adds attractive colour to salads. Eat fresh or cooked.

- Redland Pioneer 500gm - \$12; 1kg - \$20
Long flat stringless pods of good quality, old variety.

- Royal Burgandy 500gm - \$12; 1kg - \$20
Compact, producing purple pods that are stringless when young. Adds colour to salads.

- Provider 500gm - \$12; 1kg - \$20
Compact variety, pods up to 15cm. Round, green stringless.

- Windsor Long Pod 500gm - \$12; 1kg - \$20
Popular, pods flat 20cm long. Stringless when picked early. Seeds red.



BEAN - CLIMBING (*Phaseolus vulgaris*)

Take up little room and yield over a long period, provide trellis. Sow Spring-Summer.

- Blue Lake 500gm - \$13; 1kg - \$24

Popular old variety, climber to 2 metres, heavy bearer of fleshy, round, green, stringless pods to 15cm long.

- Purple King 500gm - \$14; 1kg - \$24

Flat purple pod to 18cm popular variety. Pods turn green when cooked. Adds colour and flavour to salads.

- Scarlet Runner 500gm - \$14; 1kg - \$26

(*Phaseolus coccineus*) Also known as '7 year bean'. Perennial climber to 2 metres, ornamental with scarlet flowers. Green pods are eaten when young. Mature seeds used as a soup bean.

BEETROOT (*Beta vulgaris*)

Popular root vegetable. Fast growing, bi-annual, easy to grow. Sow direct in garden. 60 days to maturity. Keep moist in fertile well drained soil, sunny position. Use in salads, soups, cooked or preserved. Sow all year except in very hot weather.

- Burpee's Golden 25gm - \$8; 50gm - \$15; 100gm - \$28

Sweet golden flesh, milder flavour, green tops used like spinach. Used in salads, cooked & steamed.

- Chioggia 25gm - \$8; 50gm - \$16; 100gm - \$30
